



Rose Skin Care Products Protocol

Restoration Peel (Mandelic Acid 30%)

In-office peel treatments to even skin tone and discoloration and to jump start a complete skin rejuvenation process. The Restoration peel can be performed in combination with a mild facial treatment for a full-service procedure.

Mandelic Acid is an alpha hydroxy acid naturally found in almond and is considered a mild exfoliation due to its large molecule.

Indications:

- Acne
- pigmented skin from Post Inflammatory hyperpigmentation
- Decreases fine lines and wrinkles

1. Review with patient their skin type, age, previous product usage and if necessary consider performing a patch test to skin for sensitivity.

2. Gently wash face with Green Tea Cleanser, rinse with water and pat dry.

3. Use the pre-peel on gauze to wipe the skin. Dry thoroughly.

4. Apply 1-2 ml of Restoration peel using a Q-tip and apply to the face using a mild rubbing action. Start with the forehead, then the sides of the face, the chin, the upper lip, the nose, the cheeks, and finally the neck.

Avoid eye areas, lips, and insides of nostrils.

5. Leave on initially for 3 minutes, building up to 5-6 minutes or more as patient tolerance increases.

6. After reaching the desired time wash off with cold water. Then use the Skin Peel neutralizer over the skin. Wash the neutralizer off. NOTE: Should redness or excessive stinging occur, wash off immediately. Pat the skin dry with a clean cotton or tissue. Do not rub the skin with the tissue.

7. Use Complexion Protection SPF35 for anti-aging and UVA & UVB protection as skin is more sensitive to sunlight after performing peel and exfoliation treatments.

8. Use Intensive Eye Therapy to finish the treatment

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
